Read My First Cookbook by Annabel Karmel. Why not try making some of the recipes at home?	Read Hunter on Holiday by Jessica and Stephen Parry-Valentine. Have you been anywhere over the holidays?	23 Talk Ask your child open ended questions such as why, what, and how. These require more than a 'yes' or 'no' response.	Sing 'Baby Koala' and talk about the different Australian animals mentioned in the rhyme.	25 Write  Make puppets and act out a story together.  Download some  Australian animal puppets here.	Play with toy animals and have fun making the animal noises and saying animal names.	27 Read Story Saturday! Read Australian Animals from Beach to Bush by Brentos.
Go outside and observe the moon. What shape is it? What else can you see in the night sky?	Read The Starting School List by Kitty Black. Good luck to all those children starting school this year.	Talk Talk about what makes where you live special to you. Look at a map of Australia and point out where you are.	Say the bouncing rhyme '5, 4, 3, 2, 1' which helps develop early number skills.	Substitute any titles you can't find or songs you don't know with books, rhymes, and songs that you already love.
